Details:

- ◆ Leave: Ranger HQ 4600 Valley Parkway Fairview Park, Ohio (only pick-up point) at 9 a.m. on Friday, May 4th on a charter bus. Vehicles may be left there.
 - ◆ Stop 1/2 way for a fast-food style lunch or you can pack your own. Not included.
- ◆ Check into the Hampton Inn, Fredrick, MD 5-6p.m. A limited number of single rooms available for an additional \$75 fee on a first come basis. A double room is included with registration.
 - ◆ Dinner at Mays Restaurant 6:30 p.m. —outdoor dining, meal not included.
 - ◆ Return to hotel. Each room has a refrigerator, microwave and coffee maker.
- ◆ Saturday, May 5th leave hotel at 8:15 a.m. to arrive at Maryland Sheep & Wool Festival at 9 a.m. Breakfast available at the hotel. A \$5 cash only admission fee. They do allow you to bring in food. There will be a cooler on the bus and you will have access to the bus during the day.
 - ◆ We will stay at the festival until everyone is ready to leave or 4 p.m. whichever comes first.
 - ◆ Stop 1/2 way back for a fast-food style dinner or you can pack your own. Not included.
 - ◆ Return to Fairview Park 11 p.m. on Saturday, May 5th. Depart for home.
